



Recommended zones for PPE wayfinding in aged care settings

Blue ZONE

Buffer areas between potentially contaminated and non-contaminated zones



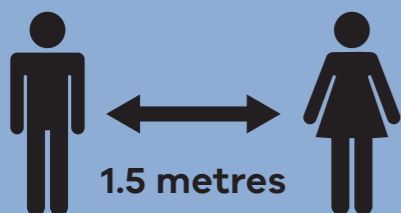
Hand hygiene



Surgical mask

Examples:

- nurses stations
- drug rooms
- corridors
- kitchens
- reception areas
- storage areas



Green ZONE

Only those with no COVID-19 risk factors or confirmed COVID-19 patients who have been cleared

Eye protection – face shield or goggles follow current DHHS directive, otherwise as per standard precautions

Gown/apron and gloves as per standard precautions

Yellow ZONE

Low-risk close contacts in quarantine

Eye protection – face shield where practical or goggles



Disposable fluid-repellent gown and gloves

Amber ZONE

High-risk close contacts in quarantine or suspected COVID-19 residents in isolation

Red ZONE

Confirmed COVID-19 residents
