



## How to safely clean your mobile phone



Perform hand hygiene **BEFORE** and **AFTER** cleaning your mobile phone



Spray 70% isopropyl alcohol solution onto a clean cloth or paper towel



Wipe the phone with the cloth or paper towel  
Or use a 70% isopropyl alcohol wipe



Do not spray cleaner directly on the phone  
Do not use bleach



Air dry before using again

Mobile phones should be kept in a cover or plastic bag that can be wiped over or discarded when you finish work

Mobile phones are highly touched and high-risk surfaces, which can become contaminated with coronavirus (COVID-19).

Mobile phones should not be used in clinical areas unless required for work purposes.

Avoid sharing mobile phones, headphones or ear pods. If they must be shared, clean and disinfect before and after use.
